Since its inception, the company has galvanized to prominence as one of the leading Manufacturer and Exporter of Greige (loom state) and Processed ROT (Printed/Dyed/Bleached) Woven fabric mainly to the European markets. We have a complete in-house setup of Sulzer looms (P7100 model) in both narrow & wider widths and also an affiliation with Air jet loom units with a capacity of over 9.5 million square meters per annum based on 60 picks.

Today our company has a much broader front. Our portfolio includes the full range of Home textile made-ups (Bedding, Kitchen & Table linen) also for seasonal, promotional customers, and Institutional textiles (Hotel & Hospital linen) with various woven constructions, processing and finishing.

We have an affiliation with top processing mills for continuous Dyeing Bleaching & Printing (Rotary, Flat bed & digital printing) in pigment & reactive/disperse both. Different variety & type of finishes are offered to our customers according to their end use and requirements, like normal standard finishing, Chintz, resin, Scotch guard, Teflon, Flame retardant, wrinkle free, Anti-bacterial, Surgical, Crepe (seersucker), Anti static, Anti soiling, Anti fungus, Silicon, water repellency, brushing finishes and different types of washing treatments like enzymes, Caustic & garment washes, all with Azo-free chemicals in Oeko-tex standards and some additional mechanical/chemical processes like Mercerizing & Sanforizing etc. to make products more customize & eco-friendly for promoting green living.

STORY OF COTTON, A CHOICE FOR SUSTAINABILITY

In the Indus River Valley in Pakistan, cotton was grown, spun & woven into cloth 3,000 years BC. Arab merchants brought cotton cloth to Europe about 800 A.D. When Columbus discovered America in 1492, he found cotton growing Bahamas Islands. By 1500, cotton was known generally throughout the world.

Our choice of producing mainly cotton based products to ascertain the advantages of consuming cotton fiber are:

- ➔ Cotton absorbs humidity inside and emits it to the outside, and plays a role of natural air-conditioner.
- ➔ It uses sunlight and converts it directly to a fiber without intermediate processing steps.
- ➔ Cotton is a food & fiber crop. Salads and cooking oils are made of cotton seed oil & cotton linters are also used in pharmaceuticals
- ➔ It uses less pesticides than many commodities, such as cereals, corn, rice & soybeans
- ➔ Cotton production uses less than 8% of the world's pesticides while meeting almost half of the textile needs.
- ➔ Easy to wash, Non Allergenic, biodegradable & recycled material as it can decompose easily.
- ➔ The energy contained in cottonseed is greater than all of the energy that it takes to produce crop of cotton.

Fabric & Made-ups produced in different compositions from 100% cotton, Organic Cotton (GOTS), Poly cotton, Viscose, 100% Polyester in spun (MJS) & filament, Lycra, Tencel (Lyocell), Slub, stretch & recycled yarn/fibers with different variety of style, design, density (GSM 90-280), Thread count (T80 – T400), widths (78-340 cm) & constructions (weave) are produced like Muslin, plain sheeting, Percales, Sateen (Plain/stripe), Twills, Drills, Canvas, Half Panama, Flannel Poplin, Waffle, Herringbone, Oxford, Chambray, Pocketing & Lining fabric etc.

- ➔ Greige (Loom state fabric) both SULZER & AIRJET.
- ➔ Processed fabric (ROT) – Bleached, Optical white, PFD, Printed & Dyed (Pigment/Reactive/VAT)
- ➔ Bed Linen – Flat sheets, Fitted sheets, Duvet covers, Cushions & Pillow cases
- ➔ Kitchen & Table Linen- Aprons, Napkins, Kitchen Towels, Oven Gloves & Mitts, Table covers (Rounded, Square, Rectangular), Placemats, Runner etc.
- ➔ Institutional (Hospital & Hotel Linen) – Flat & Fitted Sheets, Pillow Cases & Duvet. (Options with different BERGER degree, strength & shrinkage stability for washing reliability)
